

NDIS Support Coordination



DPV Health can help you with your NDIS plan by identifying what you want, help you take control, assist you to make choices and to manage the NDIS funded support services you receive.

DPV Health aim to build your capacity to coordinate and implement your support services outlined in your NDIS Plan, as follows:

Support Coordination

Assistance to manage your NDIS funding and guidance to strengthen your ability to coordinate your NDIS support and participate in the communit.

Psychosocial Recovery Coach

A recovery coach is someone who has mental health knowledge and can assist you on your mental health treatment journey to enable you to be able to utilise your NDIS plan better.

Specialist Support Coordination

Assistance for people with complex needs or in a high risk situation to strengthen your ability to coordinate support and participate in the community.

What We Do:

You may wish to use our coordination team to:

- > Access mainstream, community, informal and provider support options
- > Choose best options and provider for your needs

> Negotiate services, develop service agreements, book with preferred providers

> Arrange assessments for required funding

> Decide budget for each support type and keep you updated on your funding

> Liaise with plan manager regarding appropriate claim categories, and allocate correct funds

> Link to mainstream or community services; housing education, transport, health

> Strengthen your capacity to coordinate support, self-direct and manage support, and participate in the community.

- > Psychosocial Recovery Coach
