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Your Mental Health

Confidential and compassionate support

Get support for stress, depression, anxiety, loss and grief, , family or domestic violence, relationships, trauma, and more. Our team of skilled social workers, psychologists, occupational therapists, lived experience workers, doctors and mental health nurses are here to help.

Services include:

- > Therapy supporting you to manage the life's struggles that hurt your mental health, delivered intensively or longer term
- Care coordination help to navigate services that fit your needs. Available on a short-term basis
- Groups Assists you to improve your skills in managing distress, emotions, personal relationships, changing your thinking and behaviour
- Psychiatry our private psychiatrist sees people on a limited basis. A doctor referral is required.

DPV Health is a **Head to Health** hub in Melbourne's North.

We provide a range of support and recovery services and programs for those who use family violence, and for those who are affected by family violence.

Services include:

- > Mens' Behaviour Change Program
 - a 20-week supportive group program that helps you with feelings of loneliness, understand the causes and impact of family violence and make changes to your behaviour so you can have better relationships with your partner/expartner and children.
- Mens' Case Management Service
 provides practical and emotional support. Assists with planning and referrals to other services
- > Family Support Workers offers support to women and children and other family members who have been affected by the behaviour of men attending our Men's Behaviour Change Program. Services include educational and therapeutic counselling, support, advice and referral to other services.
- > The Orange Door offers access to a range of family violence and family services either in person or over the phone. No referral is needed. Highly trained staff respond to family violence and support the family with their wellbeing. DPV Health is the Mens' specialist in the Orange Door sites.

Your Physical Health

Supporting a healthy and active lifestyle

To support your pre-existing health problems or efforts to maintain a healthy life, our trained health professionals can assess, educate, and treat you for a range of conditions and illnesses.

Services include:

- Audiology Assessing, treating, and preventing hearing and balance disorders
- Exercise Physiology Promoting therapy and rehabilitation of injury, preventing, and managing chronic disease or disability through exercise and education
- Nutrition and Dietetics Providing nutrition information, assessments and support to help manage specific health conditions and wellbeing

- > Occupational Therapy Assisting you to maintain or recover your independence in everyday activities such as showering and dressing, getting on or off chairs/beds, cooking a meal, and moving safely around your home and community
- Physiotherapy Diagnosing and managing conditions and injuries impacting your movement, balance, pain, function, and rehabilitation
- Podiatry Preventing, assessing and treating conditions of the feet and lower limbs
- Speech Pathology Assessing, treating, and managing communication disabilities, and support if you have trouble swallowing
