



DPV Health audiologists are committed to focusing on your needs and providing you with a comprehensive diagnostic hearing assessment.

We work in close partnership with families to identify your/your child's hearing status and needs. Our audiologists are experienced in working with children, especially those with special needs.

You should seek a referral to our Audiology Service if you notice any of the following signs or symptoms:

Adults:



Trouble hearing in background noise



Difficulty hearing over the telephone



Hearing buzzing, ringing, hissing in ear



Concerns with balance or dizziness



Needing television to be turned-up loud

Children:



Concerns about speech/language development



Developmental delay and/or behavioural concerns



Asking for repeats, shouting/whispering when talking



Difficulties with concentrating



Frequent ear infections

At the full assessment:

- > We look at the ear health and hearing levels
- > You will receive the results at your appointment
- > A letter will be sent to the referrer and any other professionals, at your request





Who can use this service

Our audiology service provides diagnostic hearing assessment for infants, children and adults.

We accept self-referrals, and referrals from family members and carers, General Practitioners, Paediatricians, Specialists, Teachers, Maternal and Child health nurses or other professionals.

The service is also available through NDIS and Home Care Package Plans.

NOTE: We do not fit hearing aids but can refer you to an appropriate service if required.
