Provide education on starting injectable therapy and follow-up



Learn what affects your blood glucose level, and strategies to achieve your target levels



Understand the importance of a healthy lifestyle and learn to live well with diabetes



Understand hypoglycaemia, prevention, and management



Register with NDSS (National Diabetes Services Scheme) to access subsidised supplies



Manage your blood glucose, when unwell

This service is available to people of all ages.

We accept self-referrals, referrals from GPs, Specialists, or other health professionals.

The service is also available through NDIS and Home Care Package Plans.
