What to expect:

After an initial assessment of your child, we will create a Client Care Plan. This is a written agreement about how we can work together to help your child achieve the agreed goals.

Your child's therapy may consist of one or more of the following options:

- > Group Therapy
- > Individual Sessions
- > Home Programs
- > Monitoring and/or a Review





Who can use this service

The Paediatric Speech Pathology service is for children up to school entry age who are experiencing difficulty with their speech and language development yet have typical development in other areas.

We accept self-referrals, and referrals from GPs, Paediatricians, specialists, Maternal and Child Health Nurses, other health professionals, carers and early years educators.

Children who require long-term therapy, have needs/ concerns in two or more areas of their development or have a disability, should be referred to Early Childhood Early Intervention service (ECEI)/NDIS (National Disability Insurance Scheme).
