

We work in close partnership with families to identify you/your child's hearing status and needs. Our audiologists are experienced in working with children, and are full and accredited members of Audiology Australia.

You should seek a referral to our Audiology Service if you notice any of the following signs or symptoms:

Concerns about speech/language development Development Developmental delay and/or behavioural concerns Difficulty hearing over the telephone Asking for repeats, shouting/whispering when talking Difficulties with concentrating Concerns with balance or dizziness Frequent ear infections Needing television to be turned-up loud

Access our Private Audiology Clinics:

- We offer private clinics at our Broadmeadows and Mill Park medical centres.
- > No more long waits. Get an appointment in just 1-2 weeks.
- > No GP referral required.





At the full assessment:

- > We look at the ear health and hearing levels
- > You will receive the results at your appointment
- A letter will be sent to the referrer and any other professionals, at your request

Who can use this service

Our audiology service provides diagnostic hearing assessments for infants, children and adults.

We accept self-referrals, and referrals from family members and carers, General Practitioners, Paediatricians, Specialists, Teachers, Maternal and Child health nurses or other professionals.

NOTE: We do not fit hearing aids but can refer you to an appropriate service if required.

Fees

Fees, where applicable will be determined prior to your first visit. Please ask for details of fees while booking your appointment.

A fee of \$110 per appointment will apply for the Private Audiology clinic.


Access to Interpreter Services
